

USS Pampanito Overnight
Pack 1776 Will Live Aboard a WWII Submarine
June 11, 2010 (1830 Hours) – June 12, 2010 (0830 Hours)

Note: This event will likely sell out. Paid reservations are necessary to reserve a space!

Spend the night aboard the historic World War II submarine USS *Pampanito* (SS-383). The USS *Pampanito* is located at Pier 45, at the foot of Taylor Street, in the heart of Fisherman's Wharf in San Francisco.

The submarine has 48 bunks available for us to sleep in; however, each person is required to bring their own sleeping bag. The USS *Pampanito* regrets that siblings of visiting group members are not permitted to attend this overnight encampment.

While on board, we will have both a self-guided tour and personalized instruction by the USS *Pampanito* staff on the history and operation of submarines. A television monitor and DVD are available for viewing videos from a selection of feature submarine films while on board.

During the course of our visit, each camper will complete a submarine qualification worksheet and earn a special certificate from the USS *Pampanito* commemorating his overnight stay.



Our visit will include climbing into the conning tower (Fire torpedo one! climbing into the gun decks and participation in the morning flag raising ceremony. Regular tourists do not share this experience.

The cost for taking part in this program is \$37.00 per person (Cub Scouts and adults). This includes cold and hot water, hot chocolate, and parking for 10 vehicles. Additional parking is available for \$15. The USS Pampanito can make arrangements to have pizza delivered before the movie night located in the forward torpedo room. Scouts should have dinner before they arrive. Our group will purchase food to supply a continental breakfast on Saturday morning (bagels, juice, etc.).

Carpooling is suggested since parking spaces are limited next door. A listing of optional Saturday morning San Francisco activities will follow.
