

2010 Scouting for Food Information and Suggestions

Before Distribution

Co-ordinate your drop off areas with the other units in your elementary school enrollment district

Affix the eye glasses fliers to the SFF fliers.

If there are gated communities in your area, please contact their Home Owner Associations to obtain permission to distribute and collect in their area. If they have their own food collection program, you may offer to work with them to make their program a success – we are all working to help the same people.

Bag Distribution – November 13

You may distribute door hangers on a different day than November 13.

Wear Scout uniform.

Drivers should have all scouts in view at all times

Scouts are NOT to enter a donor's residence.

Bring a friend! A great way to introduce what Scouting is about.

Door hangers should be placed on the door or partially under the door mat
(make sure it is visible and will not blow away)

Do not put hangers in mailboxes

Bag Pickup – November 20

Food must be picked up from the same area you distributed door hangers.

Food pickup is to begin no earlier than 9:00 am, and dropped off at the collection site by 2:30 pm.

Wear Scout uniform.

Scouts are NOT to enter a donor's residence.

Bring a friend! A great way to introduce what Scouting is about.

Food collected by your Troop/Pack may be delivered:

- a) Directly to the Collection site by each driver; or
- b) To a central Troop/Pack designee who then delivers to the Collection site.

Each Troop/Pack Scouting for Food Coordinator should keep track of the number of adult and scout participants (to be reported at Collection site)

Collection Site

The Meridian District's food collection site will be open from 10:00 am to 2:30 pm and is located at:

Danville LDS Stake Center
655 Old Orchard Road, Danville

Directions: From 680 take Sycamore Valley Road exit and head east; proceed approximately one mile and turn left on Old Orchard Road; take first left turn into church parking lot.

If you miss the 3:00 closing time on Nov. 20, you may deliver the food as follows:

Take food directly to the Contra Costa Food Bank located at 4010 Nelson Avenue, Concord. Telephone # 676-7543 (open till 7:00 pm). Directions: Take Port Chicago Highway (north) exit from Highway 4; Left turn on Bates; and Left turn on Nelson. Please tell them that the food is from Scouting for Food in the Meridian District.
